What to Bring

Bus Overnight Bag

- Sleeping Bag (or Sleeping Roll with sheets, blankets, etc)
- Sleeping clothes (pajamas should be conservative for wearing in common areas)
- Toiletries (soap, shampoo, brush/comb, deodorant, toothpaste/brush, razor)
- Aspirin and other medications
- If you will want to shower, bring towel and change of clothes

On the Bus

- Pillow
- Blanket, Socks (can get chilly)
- Books and magazines to read
- Games (cards, travel games – not electronic)

Camp Bag (will stay on bus at overnight stops)

- 4 sets of work clothes
- Long pants are required at work site, no exceptions (scrubs, light-weight pants)
- 1 pair of work shoes, boots or sturdy tennis shoes (no open toes)
- 4 pairs of work socks
- Bandanas

- Modest clothes to wear after work, on day-off and on 4 travel days (see Covenant)
- Shirts, Pants/Shorts, Shoes/Sandals, Socks
- 8 sets of underclothing
- Swimming suit - conservative one-piece for women, no Speedos for men

- Backpack for Worksite
- Hat and Sunglasses
- Water Bottle
- Sunscreen (SPF 15 or higher)
- Chapstick and Insect Repellent
- Camera
- Work Gloves

- Bible, notebook and pens
- Towels and washcloths for showering
- Items from Bus Overnight Bag

DO NOT Bring

- Anything Electronic (phone, iPod, game, etc.)
- Two-piece swimsuits
- Anything forbidden in Covenant or by common sense
