#### Trip Information

Location: Navajo Reservation in Cedar Springs, Arizona  
Around 100 miles from Flagstaff, 200 miles from Grand Canyon

Mission Organization: Team Effort

Ran Hurricane Ike Mission Camp at Gloria Dei

Host of Gloria Dei Mission Trips since 2009 (Tampa, Arkansas, Navajo)

Dates: June 23 – July 1 (Saturday to Sunday)

Bus leaves Saturday morning and returns Sunday evening

Work Monday – Thursday, Recreation day on Friday

Capacity: 90 students and counselors

Spots allocated in order of deposits received (\$50)

Priority given to students

Adult Counselor Priorities: 1 per 5 students, 1 parent

Projects: Build homes, repair homes, work with families

Devotions on work-sites and worship every night

Free Time: Friday at the Grand Canyon

Afternoons at Little Painted Desert, Climbing Rock, Lookout Cave

Lodging: Church Mission Group Facility at church on Navajo Reservation

Bunk beds, showers, dining area, chapel
