Concept Question - Why was it important for God to raise prophets during the period of the kings?

#### Recalling a Destiny

Figure in red robe = The prophet

Second figure = Israel

Darkening sky in background = Prophets were sent during age of decline, preceding exile Israel focused on "I Will Bless You" = Israel felt secure in God's promises

Torn manuscript on the ground = Israel forgot responsibility to be a blessing

Prophet holds fragments before Israel's eyes = Prophet reminded Israel of destiny

Israel clasps mortar bowl & pestles to bosom = Traditions became ends in themselves

Tent of tabernacle symbol = Temple made reason for false security

Law symbol = Law became a stumbling block to justice

Separation symbol = Separation turned into a curse

Sharp rock symbol = Circumcision became a fetish

Mirror symbol = Holy land put to unholy use

Yoke symbol = Past was glorified at expense of present & future

Concept Question - Why did God have His prophets give promises of hope amongst their calls to faithfulness?

#### Pointing Ahead

Figure in center = The prophet speaks to Israel

Withered tree & barren earth = Prophets often spoke during time of crisis

Young boy points to green tree on horizon = Prophet gave hopes for Israel's future

Six manuscripts = Six specific promises of hope were given by the prophet

Concept Question - Why did God allow the Babylonians to destroy His chosen people?

#### The Exile

Two large swords in the foreground = Two deportations by powerful Babylonian forces
Burning city in the background = Jerusalem is pillaged and destroyed
Masses moving out of the burning city = Judah's citizens are taken into exile
Expression of despair on face = Destruction & exile bring great despair
Ezekiel and Jeremiah scrolls = These prophets spoke before & during exile
Woman carries infant in arms = Prophets renew hope stating that a remnant shall return

Concept Question - What causes God to intervene with man so that history is really His Story?

History Itself is the Judgment of God

Was God's promise & destiny only for the Jews? = All believers are heirs of promise When did Gentiles become part of God's plan? = From beginning, revealed thru Christ

Globe on blueprint = God has a divine plan for His world Hand crashes through blueprint = Hand of God through history Hand hold scales of justice = God's judgment ensures justice

Calendars of time = History itself is the Judgment of God (Nations follow God's call)

Two gavels between calendars = Judgment is administered while we live

Small gavel beyond surface of globe = All are judged beyond the grave

Small gavel on left = Negative aspect of judgment is to condemn evil Large gavel on left = Positive aspect of judgment is to save the lost Flowers on large gavel = God judges because of His love for all people

Concept Question - How could God use the Exile to help His people fulfill their Destiny?

#### The Restoration

Broken chain = Babylonian bondage is broken when Persians conquer Babylon

Golden seal = Cyrus issues "The Edict of Restoration" freeing the Jews

Trumpets = God's people who proclaimed hope and led the returning exiles

Haggai & Zechariah trumpets over bricks = Haggai & Zechariah pushed rebuilding temple

Nehemiah trumpet over city walls = Nehemiah led rebuilding of city walls

Ezra trumpet over law tablets = Ezra initiated law reforms
