Review of Last Week - *Empowered for a Destiny*

Figure = Israel

Murky Stream = Israel lived in a world where evil was a reality

Spotted Tunic = Evil splashes on Israel, Israel unclean with sin

Broken Note = Disobedience leads to disharmonies

Burden = Sin leads to guilt and sense of guilt

Extended Hands = Israel was called to minister to all on the earth

Figure Clutches Burden = Preoccupied with own burdens, Israel unable to minister

Lamb Between Figure & Hands = God's atoning acts free Israel to fulfill its mission

Manuscript Message = God's atonement was provided to empower Israel to "be a blessing"

Spies are Sent to Explore Canaan

(Numbers 13-14, Deuteronomy 1)

- | | | |
|----------------------|---|---|
| Numbers 13:17-20, 25 | = | Moses sends spies, Spies explore 40 days |
| Numbers 13:27-28 | = | Spies talk of great land but powerful people |
| Numbers 13:31-32 | = | Other spies say not to go |
| Numbers 14:6-10 | = | Joshua & Caleb say to go, Israelites want to stone them |
| Numbers 14:29-30, 34 | = | Only Joshua & Caleb will enter land |
| Deuteronomy 1:41-44 | = | Decided to fight, God said no, Routed by Amorites |

Israel Wanders for 40 Years

(Deuteronomy 2)

Deuteronomy 2:1, 14-15 = Israel wandered 38 years under generation had died

Taking the Promised Land - Israel Under Moses (continued)

God Directs Israel To the Promised Land

(Deuteronomy 2)

Deuteronomy 2:2-3 = *You've wandered enough, now turn north ...*

God Protected Edom, Moab & Ammon from Israel

(Deuteronomy 2:4-23)

Deuteronomy 2:4-5 = Seir given to Edomites (Esau)

Numbers 20:14a, 16b-18 = Moses asked to pass through on highway, Edom refused

Deuteronomy 2:9, 17-19 = Ar given to Moabites & Ammon to Ammonites (Lot)

Israel Defeats Eastern Amorites

(Numbers 21:21-35, Deuteronomy 2:24-3:11)

Deuteronomy 2:24-25 = Given Sihon & country, Other nations will hear of you & tremble

Deuteronomy 2:32-33 = God gives Sihon to Israel at Jahaz

Deuteronomy 3:3-4 = Israel captures Bashan from Og

Deuteronomy 3:8 = Territory covers Arnon Gorge to Mount Hermon

Masses Emerging From Desert = Israel comes to conquer

Great Sword East of Jordan = Kingdoms of Sihon and Og are crushed

Israel Blessed by Balaam

(Numbers 22-24)

Numbers 22:4-6 = Moab King Balak asks Balaam to curse Israel

Numbers 24:10 = Balaam blesses Israel 4 times

Reuben, Gad, Manasseh Settle East of Jordan

(Numbers 32, Deuteronomy 3:12-20)

Numbers 32:1-2, 4-5 = Reuben & Gad ask to stay east of Jordan

Numbers 32:33 = Moses gives land to Reuben, Gad & Manasseh

Deuteronomy 3:18-20 = R, G & M required to fight with brothers

Promised Land Described to Moses

(Numbers 33:50-35:34)

Numbers 33:51-56 = Israel commanded to wipe Canaan clean

Numbers 34:1 = Promised land defined

Numbers 35:2, 6, 12 = Levite towns & cities of refuge commanded

Leadership Passes to Joshua

(Deuteronomy 31-34)

Deuteronomy 4:1 = Moses prepares Israel for the destiny (Deuteronomy 4-33)

Deuteronomy 31:1-3 = Moses tells Israel he will not cross Jordan

Deuteronomy 31:14, 23 = God commissions Joshua to succeed Moses

Deuteronomy 34:1-5 = Moses dies after seeing the promised land

Deuteronomy 34:9 = Joshua takes charge

Joshua 3:7 = God exalts Joshua

Taking the Promised Land - Israel Under Joshua

Israel Crosses the Jordan River

(Joshua 3-5)

- Joshua 3:15-17 = God parts the Jordan River
- Joshua 4:20-24 = Stones set as a memorial of crossing
- Joshua 5:3-5 = Israelites are circumcised
- Homework Question 1* = Israel was rededicated in the promised land
- What is the significance of Joshua 5:2-9?
- Joshua 5:10 = Israel celebrates the Passover
- Joshua 5:11-12 = Manna stops
- Joshua 5:13-15 = Joshua meets angel, Promised Land is holy

Israel Conquers Jericho

(Joshua 2, 6)

- Joshua 2:1, 3, 6, 14 = Rahab protects spies, Spies promise protection
- Joshua 6:2-5 = God outlines plan for taking Jericho
- Joshua 6:20, 25 = Jericho's walls came a-tumbling down, Rahab spared
- Memory Concept: Joshua 6 - *Jericho captured* = Concepts on Homework for next week

Israel Conquers Ai

(Joshua 7-8)

- Joshua 7:4-5 = Israel loses first battle against Ai
- Joshua 7:11, 20-21, 25 = Achan's sin found & punished (separation from within)
- Homework Question 2* = Threatened God's authority for future
- Why do you think Achan's sin was so serious at this point of Israel's history?
- Joshua 8:24-25 = Ai conquered through planned ambush
- Joshua 8:34-35 = Joshua renews covenant at Mount Ebal
- Dual Swords West of Jordan* = Jericho and Ai crumble
- Memory Concept: Joshua 8 - *Destruction of Ai*

Gibeon Deceives Israel into Treaty

(Joshua 9)

- Joshua 9:3-6 = Gibeonites trick Israel and ask for treaty
- Joshua 9:14 = Israel failed to inquire of the Lord
- Joshua 9:15-16 = Israel makes treaty, then learns of trick
- Joshua 9:20-21 = Gibeonites not killed, became woodcutters & water bearers
- Memory Concept: Joshua 9 - *Gibeonite plot*

Israel Defeats Southern Coalition

(Joshua 10)

- Joshua 10:5 = 5 Amorite kings join forces against Gibeon
- Joshua 10:9-11 = Israel defeats coalition, God turns evil alliance to good
- Joshua 10:40-42 = Israel wipes southern region clean
- Sword Attached to Five Crowns* = Southern coalition is defeated
- Memory Concept: Joshua 10 - *Southern coalition*

Taking the Promised Land - Israel Under Joshua (continued)

Israel Defeats Northern Coalition

(Joshua 11)

Joshua 11:5 = Northern kings join forces to fight Israel
Joshua 11:7-8 = Israel defeat coalition forces
Joshua 11:12-14 = Israel wipes northern region clean
Sword at Base of Sea of Galilee = Northern coalition is routed
Memory Concept: Joshua 11 - *Northern coalition*

Promised Land Allocated to Tribes

(Joshua 12-22)

Joshua 13:1 (1-5) = Large areas of land remain to be taken
Red Tinges on Western Seacoast = Some areas yet untaken & threaten Israel's destiny
Joshua 13:8 = Reuben, Gad, Manasseh territories defined by Moses
Joshua 14:1-2 = Land for rest of tribes assigned by Joshua & Eliezar (Joshua 13-19)
Joshua 20:1-3 = Cities of refuge defined
Joshua 21:3 = Levite towns defined
Joshua 22:1-2, 6 = Eastern tribes return home

Joshua's Final Acts

(Joshua 23-24)

Joshua 23:6-8, 12-13 = Israel charged to obey God & remain separate
Joshua 24:14-15 = "Choose this day whom you will serve"
Figure on Rock Ledge = Israel is master of Canaan, Joshua urges loyalty to true God
Joshua 24:24-25 = Covenant renewed at Shechem
Joshua 24:29 = Joshua dies
Memory Concept: Joshua 24 - "*Choose this day whom you will serve*"

Summary - *The Conquest*

Masses Emerging From Desert = Israel comes to conquer
Great Sword East of Jordan = Kingdoms of Sihon and Og are crushed
Dual Swords West of Jordan = Jericho and Ai crumble
Sword Attached to Five Crowns = Southern coalition is defeated
Sword at Base of Sea of Galilee = Northern coalition is routed
Figure on Rock Ledge = Israel is master of Canaan, Joshua urges loyalty to true God
Red Tinges on Western Seacoast = Some areas remain untaken and threaten Israel's destiny
